The new line of RotoZip Spiral Saw technology, the RZ2000, is the most technologically advanced on the market.

One of the biggest problems with Spiral Saw tools is the amount of dust they generate. The RZ2000 has an integrated dust port that collects dust and debris for improved visibility and cleaner work stations. The improved system makes the RZ2000 perfect for trades working in occupied spaces, as well as building maintenance crews, plumbers and electricians.

The RZ2000 uses Constant Speed Control circuitry to maintain speed under load. Variable speed and a 6A motor team up with this advanced circuitry to provide higher power and improved control. This makes the RZ2000 ideal for specialty cuts in a wide variety of materials, including wood, metal, Plexiglas, drywall, ceramic wall tile and even porcelain floor tile. For more accurate cuts, the RZ2000's electronic feedback control and low vibration combine to make accessories cut more smoothly at an even speed.

To increase user intuitiveness and streamline use, the company developed the RotoZip Connect™ attachment interface. This feature provides a quicker, more secure connection than previous designs and ensures that heavier duty attachments, which could potentially damage older tools, are only used with the RZ2000. The RZ2000, combined with RotoZip Connect, offers the quality pros look for in a versatile cutting system. Newer, compatible attachments include the ZM5 Zipmate® Attachment, JSH5 Jigsaw Handle and XSHIELD™ 2 Flush Cut Guard Attachment. Existing accessories like XBITS™, XWHEELS™ and the recently launched XCORES™ are compatible with the RZ2000.

To appeal to the majority of end users, RotoZip updated the "bump" switch to a front-mounted slide switch. The RZ2000's repositioned on-off switch, which works like the switch on a typical angle grinder, creates more comfortable ergonomics for easier use and increased precision. An adjustable handle strap allows users to maintain a comfortable, steady pace for cleaner cuts while Soft Start reduces initial torque for enhanced control.



Other features of the tool include a handy on-tool wrench storage compartment, a built-in work light, replaceable motor brushes, dust sealed switch, rear cord exit, and a slim, in-line housing design. A die-cast aluminum front end provides sturdier on the job performance and durability.

The RZ2000 retails for \$159 and is now available nationwide at major home centers and industrial supply houses.
