Users can cut floor and wall tile faster and more accurately with ROTOZIP spiral saw accessories. For example, its revolutionary diamond Floor Tile XBIT contains nearly three carats of diamond grit – cutting through hard tiles such as porcelain and granite up to 1/2-inch thick with ease and efficiency. Perfect for making hole cut-outs in a variety of shapes and sizes, ROTOZIP's diamond floor tile XBIT is great for making plunge cuts required to install bathroom hardware, as well as shaping tile for installation in a sink area or around a kitchen back-splash. It is capable of making more than 45 plunges and cutting 13 linear feet of porcelain tile and eliminates the need to use multiple small cut tools such as nibblers and keyhole saws.

Making small, unique cuts or hole cut-outs in hard floor tile is no longer a difficult task thanks to the ROTOZIP Tile XWHEEL. The Tile XWHEEL is durable, doesn't require water and allows users to skillfully make curved cuts. It measures four inches in diameter and is the fastest cutting wheel in its class. It cuts smoothly through the toughest floor tiles, like porcelain and granite, with unparalleled durability and performance.

Wood Applications



ROTOZIP also offers a variety of wood applications. The patented Tracing XBIT represents the industry's first full-fledged multi-purpose tracer. For applications in a variety of materials ranging from wood to fiberglass, the tracing bit tip makes perfect cuts every time. From electrical boxes to window frames, the tracing bit eliminates the need for measurement, allowing users to quickly move on to their next home improvement projects. The 5/32-inch diameter bit is compatible with both ROTOZIP Spiral Saws and competitors' products.

ROTOZIP's Wood XWHEELS are high performance grade cutting tools. At four inches in diameter, the Wood Cutting XWHEEL features unique carbide grit for clean, fast cuts in a variety of materials, including laminate flooring, OSB, pine, plywood and paneling. For home remodeling projects, the Wood XWHEEL is perfect for making a flush cut in baseboards while installing a new floor.

Metal Applications

Featuring CBN technology, the new, high-performance Metal XWHEEL (model number: XW-MET1) allows for smooth cuts and reduces dust commonly created by abrasive wheels. The wheel's rugged CBN exterior lets users make more cuts – up to 1,800 cuts in conduit – while minimizing the downtime associated with changing abrasive wheels and maximizing jobsite productivity. At 4 inches in diameter, the newest XWHEEL cuts up to 3/4 of an inch deep. In addition, its unique dome shape makes the wheel ideal for flush cutting when paired with the XSHIELD™ guard attachment.

The ROTOZIP Metal XWHEEL is more manageable than a grinder or reciprocating saw, making it the perfect tool for everything, including installing metal door jambs, Unistrut®, conduit, copper, and garage hardware*, as well as rough-in work for plumbers, electricians and HVAC technicians. The ROTOZIP Metal XWHEEL will be available at major home centers and industrial supply houses nationwide. (*Not recommended for aluminum.)

The industry's first-ever metal cutting Spiral Saw bit, the XB-MC1, offers users an alternative to metal snips, shears, power shears, nibblers and more. Whether cutting duct work, auto body panels, gutters, aluminum siding, sheet metal or metal studs up to 18-gauge thickness, the metal cutting XBIT provides an extremely durable and heavy duty solution. Each 5/32-inch diameter bit is manufactured of solid carbide for contractor-rated applications. A drill point tip enables users to plunge directly into the material for the most complex cut-outs.

ROTOZIP's XSHIELD™ guard attachment quickly and easily converts the Spiral Saw into an ultra-compact circular and flush-cut saw. Combined with the wood and tile cutting XWHEELS, this system means more versatility for DIYers, remodelers, flooring contractors and carpenters to cut faster, farther and flush.

The ZIP MATE® turns the ROTOZIP into a multi-purpose tool for grinding, sanding, polishing and cutting for materials such as floor tile, metal bolts, iron pipe, concrete and stone. This compact attachment allows for easy maneuvering in tight spaces.

The Jig Saw Handle converts the ROTOZIP into the only 360-degree jig saw with a stable base and comfortable handle for both horizontal and vertical work, making countertop cut-outs a snap.

Drywall

The ROTOZIP Spiral Saw allows users to easily accomplish difficult cuts in drywall, including cut-outs for electrical outlets, heating registers and windows. The Spiral Saw can be paired with any ROTOZIP drywall bit such as the Drywall XBIT, contractor rated for maximum durability.
