The Tile Dock also offers maximum versatility. Its quick-clamping system secures tile sizes of any orientation and thickness – even small mosaic tile with mesh backing or brittle, fragile tile. Support can be adjusted through removable inserts. Furthermore, users have the option of mounting the Tile Dock to a table or sawhorse for an elevated working position or using it on the floor. Non-slip universal mounts secure the base by screw, bolt, clamp, foot or knee.

From plumbing fixtures and drain holes to toilet flanges and electrical boxes, the Tile Dock supports both curved and straight cuts. The quick, one-handed clamp secures tile for bull-nosing and sanding edges while cut-out templates allow users to trace common cuts. Corner tile dogs provide an extra-firm grip. Whether tackling cut-outs or cut-offs, the Tile Dock works with any portable tile-cutting tool, including: spiral saws, grinders, hole saws, nippers – even power sanders.

Constructed from structural foam, the Tile Dock is weather-resistant for long-lasting performance. Though extremely durable, its compact, lightweight structure allows for simple portability and one-person operation. Convenient storage space holds station accessories and important tools like a pencil and tape measure. Users will find that this station is not only easy to set up and manage, but the perfect complement to existing work stations.
